In September 2013, The House of Lords removed online gambling from the list of "indiscriminate vice" and transferred it instead to the list of "substance-related disorders". This made it subject to restrictions as to where and how it is marketed. By the time the 2012 review was being prepared, the House of Commons had begun an assessment of the negative effects of gambling, commissioned from "independent, world-class experts in gambling and addiction". Its report was delivered in June 2013, stating that "gambling is a serious problem in society which has a negative impact on individuals, their families and their communities, and that harms and costs to individuals, their families and to the state are significant". It recommended that gambling should be taken off the "indiscriminate vice" list, and moved under the category "substance-related disorders". In September 2013, The House of Lords conducted a review of the House of Commons report, reporting in June 2014 that while most of its recommendations were adopted, the Lords disagreed with those supporting treating Internet gambling as a 'substance-related disorder' and would instead retain its inclusion on the gambling 'indiscriminate vice' list. The other recommendations were: The introduction of state-backed legalised charities and overseen by the Charities Commission to help people with gambling problems Continuing to ban gambling advertising on TV and radio as a core public health policy to protect children On 5 April 2014, the day before the 2014 general election, the Conservative Party revealed a party policy of ending gambling advertising on TV and radio for the rest of their time in government. One of the Cabinet ministers who expressed opposition to the policy was the then Culture Secretary Ed Vaizey, who rejected a suggestion that the move could have a negative impact on children and families. Despite the possible impact on advertising, the policy was vigorously supported by gambling industry lobby group the Gambling Commission. See also Social gambling References
